The following chart shows the estimated percent of alcohol in the blood by number of drinks in relation to body weight. This chart is a guide, not a guarantee.

.04% BAC or more – Commercial drivers are under the influence.

.01% - .04% BAC – Not legally under the influence, unless proven to be physically impaired.
